

The Regina Midget Baseball program objective is simple: To provide every midget player in the City of Regina with the opportunity to play baseball under one unified structure. Here's how we accomplished this:

**1. Regina Midget Baseball Council**

- The Regina Midget Baseball Council (RMBC), which manages the midget baseball program for Regina, was formed in the spring of 2006 and has representation from Baseball Regina, Regina Little League and Regina Optimist Baseball.

**2. Coaching Selection**

- The RMBC will review coaching applications for the 2007 season and AAA coaches will be selected prior to the end of November 2006. AA coaches will be selected as early as possible in 2007.

**3. Player Evaluations**

- Player evaluations for the 2007 season will begin in January 2007. **ALL PLAYERS MUST ATTEND THE INITIAL EVALUATION – NO EXCEPTIONS**

**4. Team Formation**

- Teams will be formed by means of a citywide draft.
- One of the four AAA teams will be designated as a Little League (LL) team for purposes of the draft as well as regular season and league playoffs.
- All players must indicate which post season playoff they would prefer to participate in, namely Senior/Big League All Star Play or SBA post season play. Players cannot participate in both.
- Senior/Big League All-Star playoffs include Regionals, Canadians and World Series
- Saskatchewan Baseball Association (SBA) playoffs include Zones, Provincials, Westerns or Nationals
- In the AAA draft, the LL team will draft only players that have elected to participate in Senior/Big League All-Star play or have elected to participate in either.
- Players that that are drafted to the LL team are not guaranteed a spot on the post-season All-Star team rosters.** However, players drafted to the LL team but not selected to the final Senior or Big League All-Star team may be drafted to the roster of another AAA team for SBA playoffs.
- All teams will play in the Prairie Midget Baseball League. Numerous out-of-town teams participate in this league and therefore travel will be expected of all midget teams

**5. Registration Fees**

- 2007 registration fee will be \$250.00 per player.
- A minimum of \$100.00 must accompany this registration form with the balance of \$150.00 to be paid upon registration at evaluations. No player will be evaluated or placed in the draft unless full payment is received.
