

The Regina Midget Baseball program objective is simple: To provide every midget player in the City of Regina with the opportunity to play baseball under one unified structure. Here's how we accomplish this:

1. Regina Midget Baseball Council

- The Regina Midget Baseball Council (RMBC), which manages the midget baseball program for Regina, was formed in the spring of 2006.

2. Coaching Selection

- The RMBC will review coaching applications for the 2009 season and AAA coaches will be selected prior to the end of September 2008. AA coaches will be selected as early as possible in 2009.

3. *IMPORTANT*** ***** PLAYER EVALUATIONS ***** ***NOTE DATES*****
Evaluations for 2009 season are scheduled for Sept 20/21 and 27/28, 2008 at Optimist Park. ALL PLAYERS, WHETHER INTENDING ON PLAYING A, AA OR AAA MUST ATTEND THE EVALUATIONS. These aid in the drafting of the teams at all levels. *A separate sheet is enclosed with this form listing evaluation dates and times for all known eligible players. If your name does not appear on the list, please just attend one of the evaluation sessions.

4. Team Formation

- Teams will be formed by means of a citywide draft.
- For purposes of the draft as well as regular season and league playoffs, one of the four AAA teams will be designated as a Little League (LL) team.
- All players must indicate which post season playoff they would prefer to participate in, namely Senior/Big League All Star Play or SBA post season play. **PLAYERS CANNOT PARTICIPATE IN BOTH.**
- Senior/Big League All-Star playoffs include Regionals, Canadians and World Series.
- Saskatchewan Baseball Association (SBA) playoffs include Zones, Provincials, Westerns or Nationals.
- Players that are drafted to the LL team are not guaranteed a spot on the post-season All-Star team rosters.**
- All teams will play in the Prairie Midget Baseball League. Numerous out-of-town teams participate in this league and therefore travel will be expected of all midget teams

5. Registration Fees

- 2009 registration fee will be \$300.00 per player playing AAA or AA. A fees to be determined.
- A minimum of \$50.00 must accompany this registration form with the balance of \$250.00 to be paid upon being drafted to a team. No player will receive a uniform until full payment is received.
